

EU crisis of democratic legitimacy

- Democratic deficit reaching its limits
 - closed-door negotiations, intergovernmentalism, weak
 EU Parliament, minimal citizen engagement
- Gap between the EU and citizens is growing, confidence is plummeting,
 - 50% of EU citizens do not think their voice matters, rising extremism and nationalism


